Dividing Fractions and Whole Numbers

$$1) \quad \frac{2}{10} \div 2 = \frac{2 \times 1}{10 \times 2} = \frac{2}{20} = \frac{1}{10}$$

$$2) \quad 3 \div \frac{2}{5} = \frac{3 \times 5}{1 \times 2} = \frac{15}{2} = 7\frac{1}{2}$$

$$3) \quad \frac{1}{3} \div 6 = \frac{1 \times 1}{3 \times 6} = \frac{1}{18}$$

$$4) \quad 8 \div \frac{2}{10} = \frac{8 \times 10}{1 \times 2} = \frac{80}{2} = \frac{40}{1} = 40$$

$$5) \quad \frac{3}{10} \div 3 = \frac{3 \times 1}{10 \times 3} = \frac{3}{30} = \frac{1}{10}$$

$$6) \quad \frac{4}{5} \div 3 = \frac{4 \times 1}{5 \times 3} = \frac{4}{15}$$

$$7) \quad \frac{2}{3} \div 6 = \frac{2 \times 1}{3 \times 6} = \frac{2}{18} = \frac{1}{9}$$

$$8) \quad \frac{1}{2} \div 5 = \frac{1 \times 1}{2 \times 5} = \frac{1}{10}$$

$$9) \quad 9 \div \frac{7}{10} = \frac{9 \times 10}{1 \times 7} = \frac{90}{7} = 12\frac{6}{7}$$

$$10) \quad 10 \div \frac{4}{5} = \frac{10 \times 5}{1 \times 4} = \frac{50}{4} = \frac{25}{2} = 12\frac{1}{2}$$
