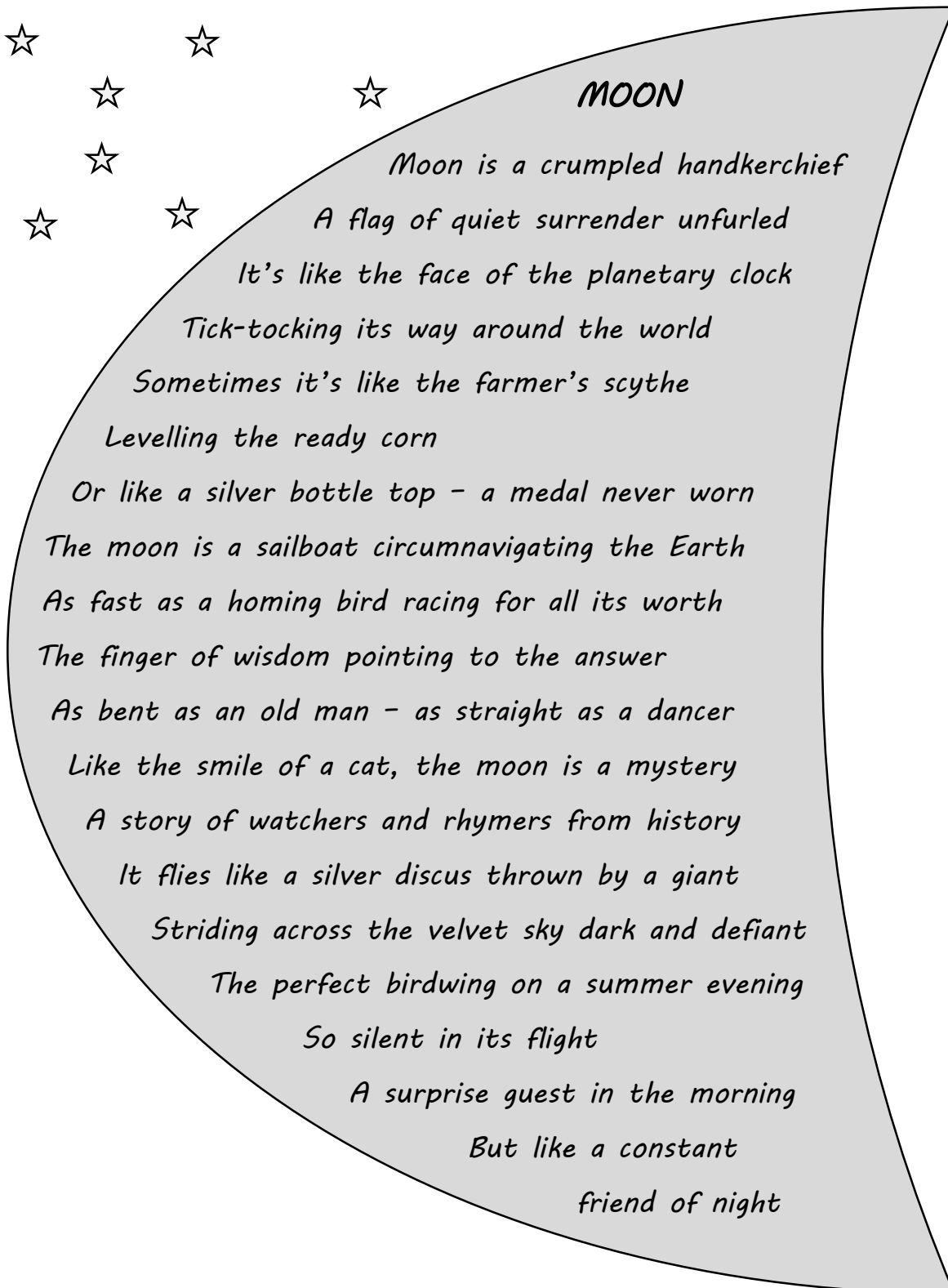


## LOOK AT THE MOON
