Warm up – Using your phase 5 flashcards ask your grown up to read out the sounds. Can you write them down?

Try using different colours to make it more fun.

Today we are going to be thinking about the two ways of saying (pronouncing) the **i** grapheme.

We can either say

- short **i** sound – tin



- a long **igh** sound – mind



Blending for Reading.

Divide a piece of paper into two.

On one side draw a picture of a **tin**. This is where your **short i** words will go.

On the other side draw a picture of a **mind**. This is where your **long igh** words will go.

Print out the attached sheet and decide whether the words go on the **short i** side of the paper or the **long igh** side.
