How to make a Monkey Card.

You will need.

- A4 card
- Paints (brown and green and other colours)
- Paintbrush
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Brown paper
- Googly eyes and sparkles/glitter if you have them



What to do.

- 1. First fold your piece of card carefully in half.
- 2. Next cover one of your hands with brown paint.

 Mickey Thompson and Purvis borrowed Ben's hand for this bit as their paws were a bit small. Ben has quite big hands so we ended up making an A4 card!



3. Press your hand firmly on the paper with your fingers pointing up towards the fold. These will be your monkeys legs.

- 4. Take off your hand and fill in any large gaps with a bit of brown paint.
- 5. Use your brown paint to add a circle shape where your thumb print is for the head and curly tail.



6. Use your green paint and other colours to add some vines at the top of the card for the monkey to swing from. Mickey Thompson and Purvis have decided to

add some flowers and bananas. I wonder what colours they will use?



7. Allow the paint to dry.

8. Meanwhile cut 2 small circles out of your brown paper.



- 9. When your monkey is dry use your glue stick to stick one circle onto the head as the monkey's face.
- 10. Cut the other circle in half and stick to the sides of the monkey's head as ears.



11. Paint the eyes, nose and mouth on your monkey or you can add googly eyes if you have them.



12. Finish with some sparkles and sprinkles for extra shine.



13. Don't forget to write your special message inside the card.
