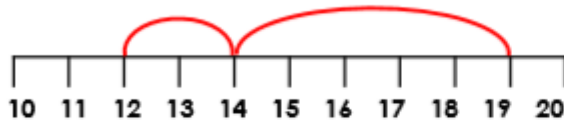


Year 1 Subtraction Problem Solving – Harder.
