

1. The key with the yellow tag is the odd one out. The pairs are: red and indigo, orange and purple, green and blue.
2. If 8 is one quarter of the whole, there must be 32 toys altogether. 24 are not in the box.
3. The combination is $\frac{9}{10}$ $1\frac{2}{10}$ $\frac{8}{10}$
4. 0.2, 0.4, 0.5, 0.7, 0.9, 1.1, 1.2, 1.7, 2.3
5. The children have 24 minutes left.
6. The puzzle spells 'hurry'
7. Answers may include: four tenths red, five tenths or one half blue, one tenth green, five tenths or one half round, five tenths or one half pointy
8. $\frac{1}{4}$ of 24 $\boxed{<}$ $\frac{1}{3}$ of 21 $\frac{1}{3}$ of 12 $\boxed{>}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ of 8
 $\frac{1}{4}$ of 32 $\boxed{=}$ $\frac{1}{3}$ of 24 $\frac{1}{3}$ of 36 $\boxed{>}$ $\frac{1}{3}$ of 33
9. The children should choose the second option because they would each get a whole pizza. The first option would give them half a pizza each.
