Superhero Cuffs

Supplies

- Coloured card
- Scissors
- 2 small cardboard tubes
- Black, gold, red, green and silver paint
- PVA glue
- Wool or ribbon
- Hole punch



– Superhero cuff templates



- 1** Cut down the entire length of both toilet roll tubes and open them out slightly ready for painting.



- 4** Use PVA glue to stick the shapes onto the cuffs. Make sure that they are stuck onto the opposite side to the cuts.



- 2** Paint both of the cuffs in your chosen colour and leave to dry.



- 5** Using the hole punch, make 3-4 holes down each side of the cuff openings.



- 3** Now decide what shapes you would like to decorate the cuff with! Either use the templates, or draw some of your own shapes onto coloured card, then cut out.



- 6** Use ribbon or wool to lace up the cuff by threading it through the holes. The cuff can now be tied up when it is worn.

Superhero Cuffs



Supplies

- Coloured card
- Scissors

Step 2. Paint both of the cuffs in your chosen colour and leave to dry.



Step 3. Now decide what shapes you would like to decorate the cuff with! Either use the templates, or draw some of your own shapes onto coloured card, then cut out.



Step 4. Use PVA glue to stick the shapes onto the cuffs. Make sure that they are stuck onto the opposite side to the cuts.



Step 5. Using the hole punch, make 3-4 holes down each side of the cuff openings.



Step 6. Use ribbon or wool to lace up the cuff by threading it through the holes. The cuff can now be tied up when it is worn.
