## Activity 1. (Blending for reading)

## Activity 2. (Segmenting for spelling)



Have a go at copying out your tricky words. You could do this outside if you have chalks or a paintbrush or water. Alternatively try spreading some flour on a work surface and write the words with your finger.

How many can you write?

Parents – tricky words are high frequency words which cannot be sounded out phonetically. The only way to learn to read and write these is lots of practise I'm afraid!
