Remember a **full stop** goes at the end of your sentence. This is when you have finished saying something.

If you have an **and** you are joining 2 sentences so you don't need a **full stop**.



A capital letter always follows a *full stop* at the start of a sentence and is also used for

- Names of people and places
- I
- Days of the week
- Months of the year
