Here are some short videos that give us a bit more insight into his work.

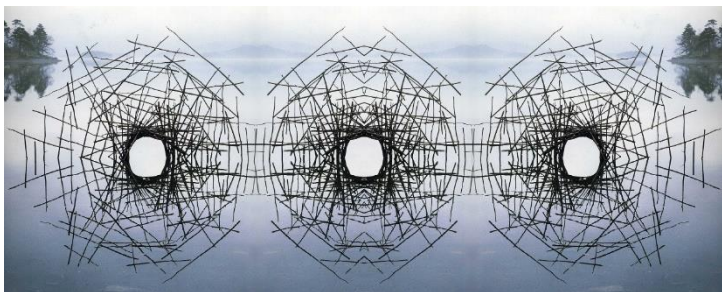

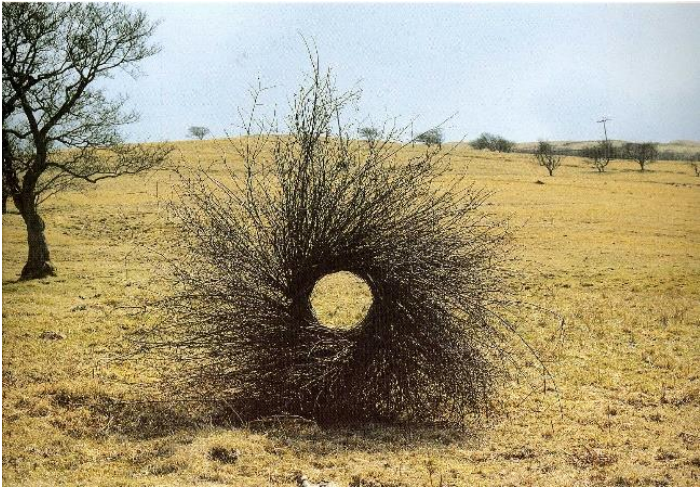
I like the work he does that has a circular theme I find it very calming and beautiful to look at.
