



	Measures in place to minimise the spread of covid - 19
Mixing between classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classes in KS2 are not going to mix. During the afternoon sessions, we will use TAs and virtual learning options to allow input of the curriculum. • Teachers may move between the groups, but pupils will remain in their classes. • Pupils to work in fixed spaces in KS2 and avoid changing seats regularly for different lessons. • Minimise the sharing of equipment in KS2
Mixing within the classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Desks in Merlins to be as spread out as possible to reduce contacts and pupils to maintain a fixed learning spot in the classroom.
Ventilation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Doors must be kept open and staff to check CO2 monitors regularly. If the reading is over 800 PPM extra ventilation required. If above 1200 pupils to go outside for a break.
Visitors to school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only essential visitors permitted in school • All visitors to wear face masks when in or around school • All visitors to sanitise hands on entry to the school
Wrap around – Abberley Acorns and breakfast club	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage the children to be outside as much as possible • Have children in years 5 and 6 to base themselves in the library with younger children in the hall • Maintain high levels of ventilation particularly if readings on the CO2 monitor go above 1200PPM • Wash hands on arrival at Abberley Acorns • Clubs may combined some groups where necessary. However, pupils should wash hands when they arrive and social distancing is to be encouraged.
Staff distancing and measures for staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff to avoid communal areas where at all possible • Facemasks to be worn in corridors and staff room • Wash or sanitise hands regularly • Staff meetings will take place virtually • Staff to avoid mixing in other classrooms and to eat their lunch in their own base room or outside

Minimising using shared spaces at lunchtimes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • KS2 to minimise use of hall and library as much as possible • KS2 packed lunch pupils to eat their lunch in their classrooms at 12pm with TAs/teachers supervision. • Merlin’s hot dinner pupils to come into the hall when there are minimal other pupils in the hall eating.
Additional cleaning after lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Additional cleaning in place to wipe key touch points down after the lunch break. Key points include: Door handles, taps, photocopier
Minimising touching of handles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Doors to the library and hall to remain open throughout the day
Pupils to use consistent toilets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wrens pupils to use the Early Years toilets, Skylarks to use the main school toilet, Kingfishers to use the mobile toilet, Kestrels and Merlins to share the C3 toilet.
Missing education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Communication with parents to ensure all pupils who are well enough have access to remote learning. KS2 pupils will have some hybrid lessons where this is deemed appropriate and particularly for pupils in years 4-6. Younger pupils to be set activities and provided with video lessons such as Oak academy or Little Wandle phonics.
Donning and doffing PPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All staff have reviewed training on donning and offing PPE COVID-19: personal protective equipment use for non-aerosol generating procedures – GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)
Shared use of laptops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laptops to be wiped after use and when returned to the trolley using anti-bacterial wipes
