

Easter Egg Crack the Code Instructions

You may wish to print the resources out on A3 size for this activity.

1. Laminate the Clue Eggs.
2. Hide the Clue Eggs in the outdoor area but keep the example egg to show the children.
3. Place the Crack the Code Activity Sheet on a table outdoors with pencils.
4. Work with a group of five children. They will have two goes each, finding two eggs.
5. Show the children the example egg. Model adding the total of mini eggs on the Clue Egg and match the number to the letter on the Crack the Code Activity Sheet. This will be the letter H.
6. On the activity sheet, model writing the letter H in the box with the number 6 underneath it.
7. Ask the children to start by finding one egg each.
8. The children will find the total of mini eggs on their Clue Egg, match the number to the letter on the activity sheet and write the letter in the box which has their total underneath it.
9. Allow the children to have a second go.
10. Read out the secret message and crack the code - Happy Easter!
