



Literacy – How you can help?

- When sharing stories with your child stop and discuss the text to check understanding. Use questions such as What do you think will happen next? How will they solve the problem?
- Play rhyming games and sing nursery rhymes or simple songs.
- Help children learn how to read and write their own name.

Mathematics – How can you help?

- Practise counting objects in practical situations with your child, for example when laying the table.
- Practise recognising small groups of objects without counting 1-1, e.g. the dots on a dice.
- Sing number songs with your child to practise counting forwards and backwards.
- Talk about the shapes you can see in the environment.
