This is our home corner. All the children love to play in here. We can cook dinner, dress up or even do the hoovering!


This is our maths area,

Our tuff trays are always full of exciting activities. This one is Jurassic World!




Every week we explore the wider school grounds. We spend time in our forest school, wildlife or garden area so we need our wellies! We also have waterproofs to keep us dry when it rains.
