


# Welcome to **Abberley Parochial V.C. Primary School**

Our school vision is based on Paul's writings to the Ephesians: Ephesians 3:17-19



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
# What does a day look like in Reception?

A timetable of a typical day in Wrens Class

8.50 am – 9.00 am	Register and Calendar
9.00 am – 9.30 am	Little Wandle Phonics 
9.30 – 10.00 am	English activities including reading, writing and handwriting 
10.00 am – 10.15 am	Snack and story time All children receive free milk up until their 5 <sup>th</sup> birthday and a free piece of fruit.
10.20 am – 10.40 am	Collective Worship
10.40 am – 10.55 am	Play time
11.00 am – 11.45 am	Maths activities 
11.45 am – 12.00 pm	Lunch
1.00 pm – 1.15 pm	Register and Circle Time
1.15 pm – 3.00 pm	Topic or RE or PE or Outdoor Learning (Topic work can consist of science, history, geography, art, music or design and technology activities) 
3.00 pm – 3.20 pm	Tidy up time in preparation for Home Time (Singing, Story or Show and Tell)

Learning in Reception takes place through a mixture of whole class learning, adult led small group activities and continuous provision.

As part of our continuous provision in the classroom we have Rainbow Challenges to ensure the children experience all the different areas of learning.



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# Little Wandle Phonics Programme.

- Daily phonics teaching.
- Phonemes for reading and graphemes for writing.
- Blending words to read and segmenting words to spell.
- Non-phonetic “tricky” words.
- Weekly phonics homework.
- Phonic matched reading scheme
- Half termly assessments.



# What can you do to help your child prepare for school?

- Read (and if possible write) their name
- Get changed for PE
- Do their coat up
- Practise counting
- Enjoy sharing stories
