



Ideas for the holidays

If you would like to follow our topic at home and prepare your child for their next learning steps here are a few ideas to try that will help lead into this new topic and also link to the new Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum:

- Have a look at our local environment if you go out walking over the summer. What sort of farms can you see? Are they growing crops or do they have animals? Why might a farm keep that type of animal?
- If you are visiting the supermarket with your child you could talk about the different foods you see. Which do they like best? Which are the healthiest? Are they grown locally or do they come from other parts of the world?
- How about sharing some stories? Discuss what happens in the story and how the characters behave/feel. Should the animals have helped the little red hen? Should the little red hen have shared the bread at the end of the story?

Included with this letter are some "Proud Peacock" sheets. If your child achieves something over the holiday that they are proud of, please fill in the sheet so we can celebrate with them at school. Any added decorations or photographs to the peacocks would be most welcome as we would like to display them on our "Proud Peacock" board in the classroom.
