Warm up -

Your sound today is **ear**.

ear is one of our trigraphs. It is a tricky one because as well as appearing in words, it also makes a word on it's own.

Can you see what Mickey Thompson and Purvis got up to on their hunt around the house for **ear** words.



Activity 1. (Blending for reading)

Print off the **ear** real and nonsense words attached and have a reading race.

Ask your grown-up to sit at one end of the room or garden with the words. You start at the other end with a dish or hoop to put the words in. Run to your grown up and read the word. If you get it right you get to take it back to your dish/hoop. If you get it wrong it goes to the bottom of the pile. How long will it take you to read all the words?

Activity 2. (Segmenting for spelling)

Go onto www.phonicsplay.co.uk

Click on **Phase 3 (purple tab)**.

Click on **Rocket Rescue** and see if you can build the rocket by spelling the words.

Parents - this activity uses all the phase 3 sounds not just the one learnt today.
