Our sound family this week is the

ee sound family.

Today we are going to look at the **e-e** split

digraph making the **ee** sound. Another sound jumps in the middle of the two sounds. It can take the children quite some time to become confident with split digraphs particularly when writing.

The **e-e** split digraph is one of our less common split digraphs.

Mickey Thompson and Purvis have found some cards with numbers on.

Can you see what type of numbers they are?



Activity 1 (blending for reading).

Print off the **e-e** real and nonsense words attached and have a reading race.

Ask your grown-up to sit at one end of the garden with the words. You start at the other end with a dish or hoop to put the words in. Run to your grown up and read the word. If you get it right you get take it back to your dish/hoop. If you get it wrong it goes to the bottom of the pile. How long will it take you to read all the words?

Activity 2 (segmenting for spelling).

Print off the **e-e** board game.

Can you spell the words as you go around the board?

See if you can write some sentences containing the words.
