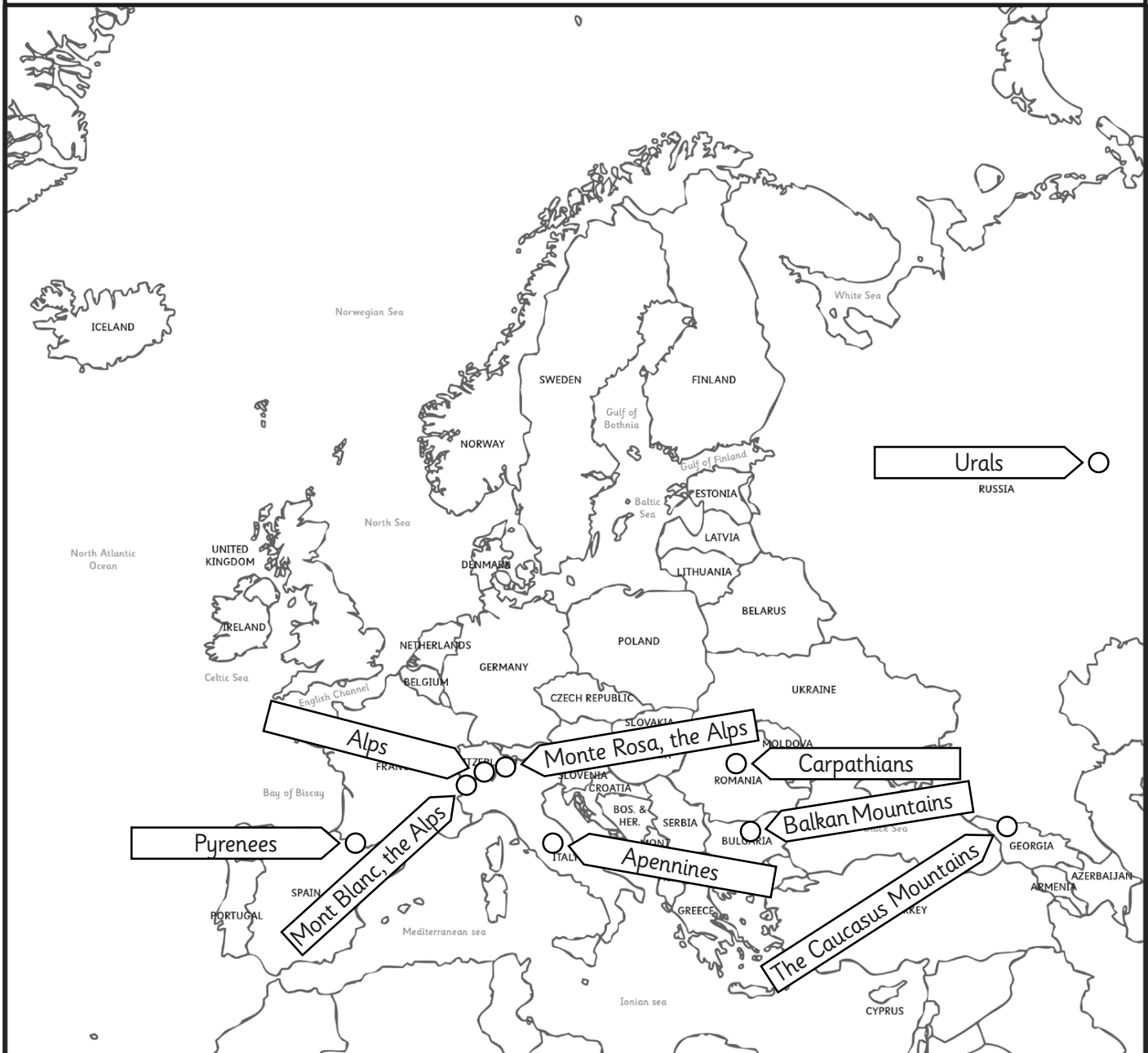




Locating Mountains **Answers**
