



Here are some photographs of the seeds I planted last week.

Were your predictions correct?

These seeds had water, light and soil and have started to grow. The seedling is a nice bright green and has some small leaves.

The seed on the right had soil and light BUT no water. The seedling is much paler in colour and has not developed leaves like the nice bright green plant next to it.





These seeds had water and soil BUT no light. There are no signs of growth.



I was surprised that the seed without water had grown at all. I started to think about why that might have happened. What do you think?
